VOTER APPROVED MEDICAID EXPANSION

- 53% of Utah voters approved this plan and budget.
- Covers 150,000 Utahns who earn less than \$17,238/year.
- Unlocks more than \$800 million in federal funds each year to help Utahns.

PARTIAL MEDICAID EXPANSION

- Lawmakers changed the plan, limiting coverage to Utahns earning less than \$12,492/year.
- Covers as few as 70,000 Utahns and arbitrarily caps coverage when needed most.
- Costs state more and leaves millions of dollars for Utah on the table.
- Likely to be challenged in court, wasting Utah's time and money with costly litigation.
